Dear Friends,

We are so excited that **Holly's Quilt Cabin** is helping us with our trip to Haiti to change 23 women's life for the better by teaching them to sew to support their family. The Haitian women are mostly uneducated and are lucky to eat one meal a day of beans and rice. Our mission is to teach 23 women to sew on crank Singer Sewing machines to provide income for their family's basic needs-food and wood to cook with. Electricity is available only a few times a week. These women will be given a microloan to start their business after their training. We will be teaching for one full week in Cap-Haitian and Port-au-Prince.

This trip will cover three of the prongs to our seven-point mission in evangelizing and loving the people in Haiti. The Haitian Collaboration will focus on education and food relief for this trip. Classes in truck mechanics, electrical wiring and sewing will be taught. Money will be raised for food which will be purchased and distributed to the Haitians. If you would like to help with food, write a check to Littleton Church of Christ and in the memo line put Food for Haiti. This is a tax deductible donation.

A simple tote bag is like a car to the people we are helping. They carry their supplies in their clothing. Many of the young children are naked. We are attaching a dress pattern and invite you to sew dresses to send. Boy's shorts and pants are in high demand also. We will be helping a school of 600 children with food and clothing. The schools are not public in Haiti and the boys must wear blue pants and solid black shoes with blue socks. We will be given out all these items at the school. We also have 2 orphanages to supply.

The sewing items we still need for the sewing supplies for each lady (new or used):

23 rotary blades (new)
13 small rotary mats 12 x18 - Large mats will be cut in to 4 mats
16 rulers 3 x 18
4 pairs of dressmaker scissors



100% cotton to make dresses (2/3 yd to 1 1/2 yds per dress) Tote bags 1 yd. Holly's fabric is wonderful!

Lace, buttons to decorate dresses.
zippers, velcro, elastic
